- Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Program is a free service in preparing taxes and qualifying for Earned Income Tax credits.
- First-Time Home Buyers Program provides information designed to educate potential first-time homebuyers about what the requirements are in order to purchase a home.
- Emergency Shelter Grant Program (ESG) prevents individuals and families from becoming homeless by providing rental assistance to qualified individuals or families in emergency or crisis.
- Youth Leadership Development Institute (YLDI) designed to help the unemployed and underemployed obtain employment and increase their marketable skills in order to successfully enter the workforce.
- ♦ Life Enhancement Services (LES) provider of behavioral health services to children, adolescents and adults, allows us to offer the whole family support with mental health needs.
